In Australia camels eat the fruit, stem and leaves of many trees including Mulga, Spinifex, Saltbush, Pigweed and honey from *Grevillea* flowers. Camels also eat salty plants, and native plants like Quandong or Native Peach Tree. They'll eat grass but it's their least favourite food, like Brussels sprouts for us! Pretend you are hosting a dinner party for your camel friends. Write a menu describing the food you will serve. Include three courses - entrée, main and dessert. Use your imagination and make up some delicious camel food like deep fried pigweed, coated in the honey from a *Grevillea* flower served with a side of Spinifex. Or as camels are known to eat strange things - old boots slowly boiled then sautéed with native peaches served on a bed of dirty socks. You may like to look up some other foods camels eat to help you.
